Since you have tested **positive**, you will need to **contact your primary healthcare provider immediately** to inform them of your results. According to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, you must stay away from others and quarantine at home. For full instructions, visit the CDC website at www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/if-you-are-sick/end-home-isolation.html

You will also need to self-isolate at home until all three of these conditions are met:

- It's been 10 days since your symptoms first appeared;
- You have gone 24 hours with no fever without the use of fever-reducing medications; and
- Your other symptoms of COVID-19 are improving*

*Loss of taste and smell may persist for weeks or months after recovery and need not delay the end of isolation

Check your temperature at least twice daily as well as keeping a daily record of fever, cough or any other symptoms including onset of new symptoms. A fever is considered anything above 100.4 for at home readings. Contact your healthcare provider if symptoms worsen over 24-48 hours. If you need to seek out medical care, contact your provider before coming into their office and inform them of your positive test results. Avoid public transportation, ride sharing or taxis if possible.

Call 911 and alert the operator you have tested positive for COVID-19 if you experience these or any other symptoms that are severe or concerning:

- Trouble breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion
- Inability to wake or stay awake
- Pale, gray or blue-colored skin, lips or nail beds, depending on skin tone
